## WELCOME SPEECH : JOYCE PULLICINO - PRESIDENT GENERAL MALTA CATHOLIC ACTION.

I would like to congratulate each and everyone of the organisers, in particular for choosing such an important theme for our consideration.

The Church, indeed Christ, relies on us to fertilise our working and living environment with the wisdom of His teachings. This we do by searching individually and together for His guidance. This is what we shall be doing during this seminar.
