The past always has its charm and speaks to us of the life of our loved ones with all their human experience. This material has attracted the kids who assimilated the contents. It was also an opportunity to learn new prayers, different ways to turn to the Lord, the life of Jesus, Mary and the saints told with new language and images. Traditional festivals full of signs and colors that risk being forgotten over time, have been rediscovered and compared with our way of living, celebrating and being together with our family, with neighbors, by a new belonging to the community. Many of our children's grandparents are illiterate and while they tell about their way of celebrating Christmas, Easter and patronal feasts, they also convey the simplicity and joy that united everyone. In the past, faith was internalized, which is why it was preserved even during the harsh dictatorship of the atheistic system that our people lived.

The pandemic has given children the opportunity to spend a long time with their grandparents and thus get to know a world they would otherwise never have known. After having collected all this material, during the Holy Easter period, it was read and told by the young people themselves and then broadcast by Radio Maria Albania.

A wonderful experience for the children, their families and the whole community, a strong help to remain in communion, to live the Easter joy and the relationship with the Lord of history.

The same boys prepared messages of hope and Easter greetings that, inserted in helium balloons, were flown to the sky to be in communion with the world in pandemic.

And, like St. Francis, we tried "to touch hearts" without thinking of our advantage, but with the only desire

to recognize that we are deeply united with all creatures and on the way to a new light that never goes out.
