Once again we express our solidarity with our brothers and sisters in Myanmar who are suffering the blows of authoritarianism and violence.

We know that this journey together as the People of God is a fundamental value of the Church in Asia, regardless of the name of the institution, movement or expression of lay Pastoral, what matters is to live the synodal spirit. As Pope Francis said to Italian Catholic Action on 30 April last, "synod is not so much a plan to be planned and implemented, a pastoral decision to be taken, but first and foremost a style to be incarnated. In this sense, your Association is a "gymnasium" of synodality, and your attitude has been and can continue to be an important resource for the Italian Church, which is questioning itself on how to develop this style at all levels. Dialogue, discussion, research, but with the Holy Spirit".

At our II International Meeting in Rome on 27.4.2017 the Holy Father told us: "Catholic Action's mission has been and has to form lay people who assume their proper responsibility in the world. Today, in concrete terms, it is the formation of missionary disciples. Catholic Action's charism is the charism of the Church itself, deeply incarnated in the today and here of every diocesan Church which, discerning in contemplation and keeping in mind its people's lives, looking for new ways of evangelizing and of carrying out its mission, starting from the different parish realities"

Catholic Action has to offer the diocesan Church a mature laity that serves with availability to the pastoral projects of each place as a way of realising its vocation".
